Rubbish and recycling collection

Building work and planning applications

After a rather quiet period, approved building work has now got underway at 24 The Park and at the rear of 23 Kenilworth Road. A major development for student accommodation has now just started in Hastings Road near West Ealing station. A bit nearer to home, there have been further details of the planned (mainly student accommodation) development at Exchange Plaza on Uxbridge Road. To add to that, a planning application has just gone in for CP House on Uxbridge Road to be knocked down and replaced with some offices and more student accommodation.

E-bike and E-scooter bay on Kenilworth Road

Nobody seems to have spotted any advance notices about the introduction of this bay, and there are concerns about its safety so near to the junction with Warwick Road. There are further issues with the bikes falling over and being parked outside

the boundaries of the bay (see below), plus noise nuisance as the bikes are serviced late in the evening. Representations to the council about this have so far met with limited success. However, you can now find out how to report e-bike parking problems to their operators [here](#) and you can also report some problems to the council on the Love Clean Streets app under the category “abandoned bikes”.

School streets and Stop and Shop

For those that haven't yet noticed, there are now restrictions on driving near local schools around the start and end of the school day, during term times only. There is a map of affected schools [here](#).

You must also use the PayByPhone app to get 30 minutes of free parking in any Stop and Shop area. You may want to switch off SMS notifications otherwise you will be charged for these.
